## **ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS**

- Assessing pupils in order to establish eligibility for extra time or a scribe, and providing evidence towards the need for a reader, in GCSEs, Functional Skills, Level 1, 2 and 3 qualifications, A Levels, BTEC and International Baccalaureate courses as well as other vocational qualifications covered by JCQ.
- Using up to date assessments, approved for access arrangements testing.
- Completing Form 8 Part 2 and giving advice towards the access arrangements which would be appropriate and documented in Form 8 Part 3.

- Hold either SpLD Assessment Practicing Certificates or a Level 7 qualification in Psychometric Testing in line with the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) regulations.
- Have many years' experience of assessing pupils for access arrangements.
- Receive annual refresher training in order to ensure that they are up to date with changes to the JCQ regulations.

### **Pricing structure**

The amount of time needed to assess pupils for access arrangements will vary (often considerably) from pupil to pupil. Access arrangements are therefore purchased as either 2 hour or 3 hour sessions, rather than per pupil.

As a guide, we would generally expect to be able to assess 3 pupils in a 2 hour session and 4 pupils in a 3 hour session but, as explained above, this can vary dependent upon the particular needs of each pupil.
